CITY OF SEDALIA SANITATION ROUTES AND RECYCLING SERVICES CHANGE EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 3, 2016

(SEDALIA, MISSOURI): As a reminder, the City of Sedalia sanitation routes will change on Monday, October 3, 2016 with the additional single-stream curbside recycling service being provided on the same day as trash service. With the start of the curbside service, commingled containers will no longer be provided at the local drop-off sites. Glass collection containers will continue to be provided at all three of the City's drop-off sites as glass cannot be included with single-stream materials.

Residents are encouraged to have separate containers for their trash versus their recycling, with the containers marked "T" for trash and "R" for recycling. If only one container is available, trash may be placed in bags with recycling materials placed in the container. We ask that you leave some space between the trash and recycling containers/bags to help our City crews in identifying the different materials. City crews will pick up recycling first and then regular trash. While there is no limit on the amount of trash cans or trash bags used, please be aware there is a 35 gallon and 75 pound weight limit per trash can or bag.

The City of Sedalia's Materials Management Site, located at 27822 Highway U, is open 7 days a week, excluding City Holidays, from 7:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. for collection of electronic waste and glass. Household hazardous waste disposal is provided to residents by appointment only as a certified technician must be on hand to process the materials. Residents may schedule a time to drop off their household hazardous waste by calling (660) 827-3000, extension 1166.

The Glass Recycling Collection Sites are available at Thompson Hills Shopping Center, 3107 West Broadway Boulevard and at 1002 S. Massachusetts Avenue.
